The urban vein

The process of approach started with a careful analysis of the present situation of Cagliari in the field of economy, sociological factors and urban issues. Geographical information was filtered, and the site of interest evidenced: a historically important, but underestimated road leading from the city center along the mountain of Tuvixxedu up to the suburbs. This 3 km long urban road was the starting point of my project due to its ambiguous role of the connection and disconnection between the city and the hinterland. The main focus of the project lies on seeing the potential of an urban project at different scales offering a variety of new urban and architectural proposals. The theme of shared economy supports the main goal of the project by creating a territorial impact influencing different levels including social and economic factors.

To realize the project, a method was developed to introduce city planning in fragments. A strategy which follows the logic to work in different scales in the urban fabric to elaborate a complementary overview of different definition of detail. Therefore, an urban proposal on the architectural scale was developed in favor to host the principles of shared economy and new typologies were developed favoring a sustainable and flexible use.
